

This is a transponder event – this is a pre-nominated event and nominations must be received before 10pm on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> March 2017. Late nominations will be accepted until 1.30pm on 11 Mar 2017 (Manual Entries only after 10pm on 9<sup>th</sup> Mar 2017) IAW Policy 12 for an ID round. All late nominations will attract a late fee of \$20 and will be placed into existing classes – no new classes will be made. They must also be prepared to pay \$155 for a transponder if the allocated transponders have all been issued.
